**Who is eligible to apply for the scholarship?**

Applicants must be a promising minority student and resident of Tennessee who is a college sophomore or junior, by the application deadline. Applicants must be enrolled full-time in an accredited college or university program with the intent to obtain a degree to pursue a career in the field of health care. A full list of criteria is noted on the scholarship application.

**What is the deadline to apply?**

**When will recipients be notified of the award?**

Recipients will be notified of the award in May 2013. Awards will be disbursed directly to the college or university in the name of the student in advance of the fall semester.

**How many scholarships are available?**

Three scholarships are available. Scholarships will be awarded to students representing West Tennessee, Middle Tennessee and East Tennessee (one in each region).

**How often is the scholarship awarded?**

Scholarships will be awarded once per year and are non-renewing.
